Research Analysis

HB 2217 classifies all premises where marijuana is licensed to be cultivated, grown, processed, stored or manufactured located within an unincorporated area and outside any corporate municipal limits as zoned for agricultural use, provided that the county or political subdivision regulates land use and implements zoning classifications for the location. The measure clarifies that nothing in the bill shall be construed to supersede the provisions of the Oklahoma Medical Marijuana and Patient Protection Act or limit the regulatory authority of the Oklahoma Medical Marijuana Authority.
