Research Analysis

HB 2273 provides that it is unlawful to willfully publish on a public online site or forum, attempt to publish or conspire to publish on a public online site or forum personally identifiable information of a law enforcement officer with the intent to threaten, intimidate, harass or stalk, and, as a result, causes, attempts to cause or would be reasonably expected to cause substantial emotional distress or financial loss to the law enforcement officer. Punishment is a misdemeanor.

Fiscal Analysis

HB 2273, as introduced, creates new law that makes the publishing to a public online site or forum of the personally identifiable information of a law enforcement officer with the intent to threaten, intimidate, or harass unlawful.

The measure creates a misdemeanor for the first violation of the provisions of the measure and a felony for a second or subsequent violation of the provisions of the measure.
