Research Analysis

The Senate amendment to HB2367 adds that the certification may also be licensed, accredited, monitored, or contracted by the Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services.

HB 2367 creates a new law stipulating that a child sixteen (16) years of age or older may enter into contracts to obtain housing if they receive a certification of unaccompanied status from a youth services provider with the Department of Human Services or the Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services. The certification shall show that they determined the child is homeless or a victim of domestic violence or abuse. The provider is required to notify the parent or guardian that the child is seeking unaccompanied child status. Certification of this status does not discharge the parent or guardian of parental or legal authority
