**Research Analysis**

The Committee Substitute to HB 2401 modifies which felons are prohibited from possessing a firearm by restricting the prohibition to those with a violent felony or 85% crime conviction. The measure removes a prohibition regarding a convicted felon being a vehicle containing a firearm. The measure removes the requirement that a nonviolent offender receive a full and complete pardon in order to apply for a carry permit, instead requiring the person to not have any other convictions for 5 years.
