## Fiscal Analysis

HB 2465, as introduced, authorizes the Department of Public Safety to approve and enter into agreements with certain entities to act as proctors for written examinations required to attain all classes of licenses and endorsements. The entities include local school districts, institutions of higher learning, and the Oklahoma Department of Career and Technology Education.
