Modifies Guidelines Requires Certain Written Agreements

Research Analysis

HB 2466 amends the Local Development Act guidelines to specify that the tools of the Act are not to be used in areas where investment, development and economic growth is occurring at a rate consistent with, or greater than, the governing body's jurisdiction as a whole. Additionally, the measure provides that tax increments described by the Act are only allowed for the portion of the tax under jurisdiction of another local taxing entity by written agreement between the other taxing entity and the governing body.
