Research Analysis

HB 2548 creates the Uniform Power of Attorney Act. The model legislation adopted in approximately 30 states brings uniformity to the power of attorney in the various states in probate procedures. The measure provides definitions and procedures used in the act regarding the use of power of attorney.

The measure repeals various existing Oklahoma statutes regarding power of attorney that are now addressed in the Uniform act. They are:
