Research Analysis

The Senate amendment to HB2663 states that requests for absentee ballots must received by appropriate election officials by 5pm on the third Monday before the election. Additionally, a registered voter may apply for an in-person absentee ballot from 8am to 6pm on the Thursday and Friday immediately preceding any election conducted by a county election board, 8am to 2pm on the Saturday immediately preceding a General Election, Primary Election, Runoff Primary Election or Presidential Preferential Primary Election, and 8am to 6pm on the Wednesday immediately preceding a General Election.

Fiscal Analysis

HB 2663 with Senate Amendments incorporated would add a day of in-person absentee voting for Presidential elections. Officials for the State Election Board (SEB) estimate the change to cost SEB approximately \$40,000 per Presidential election. County election boards would also experience related increased costs. Oklahoma County estimates a cost of \$34,000, while Tulsa County estimates a cost of \$20,000, the other 75 counties would also see increased costs though in lesser amounts.
