HB 2674 transfers the Oklahoma Medical Marijuana Authority from the State Department of Health to the Alcoholic Beverage Laws Enforcement Commission and sets forth provisions of the transfer process.

**Fiscal Analysis**

Per the OMMA, the fiscal impact of this bill is difficult to anticipate. Expected costs include person-hours needed to plan for and oversee this transition, the need to move personnel and equipment, possible expansion of office space, loss of access to infrastructure resources currently shared between OSDH and OMMA that may not be available through ABLE (e.g. fleet vehicles), stopped production/time lost on projects, etc. These costs may be substantial and other unforeseen costs are likely.
