## **Research Analysis**

HB 2685, as introduced, extends the sunset on the State Board of Veterinary Medical Examiners to 2025. The measure authorizes the board to give scholarships to individuals advancing toward degrees in veterinary medicine from Oklahoma higher education institutions. An active duty servicemember or their spouse who is licensed, registered or certified in veterinary medicine or as a veterinary technician in another state would be able to apply for reciprocal licensing in Oklahoma.

The bill updates the definition of *telehealth* and adds a definition for *probable cause committee*. Some expired statutory language is removed.
