Research Analysis

The Senate amendments to HB2693 strike the title, enacting clause, the entire bill and insert new language requiring the State Department of Education (SDE) to create a professional development program to help teachers provide instruction in civics. The programs shall emphasize:

- The structure and relationship between the national, state, county and local governments,
- Simulations of the democratic process,
- Content of the U.S. Naturalization test

The Senate amendments to HB2693 also:

- Eliminate the state-mandated U.S. History exam
- Establish a microcredential for civics teachers.
- Authorizes teachers with such microcredential to receive a one-time \$3,000 salary supplement, subject to the availability of funding.
