Research Analysis

HB 2733 creates Ida's Law. The measure directs the OSBI to coordinate with the U.S. Attorney's Office and the U.S. Department of Justice to obtain federal funding to coordinate efforts and gather data to address missing and murdered indigenous person in Oklahoma. Once funds are secured, OSBI is to create an Office of Liaison for Missing and Murdered Indigenous Persons to work with state, tribal and federal law enforcement agencies on missing persons and homicide cases involving American Indian individuals. The liaison is to develop protocols and assist families, tribal agencies and other entities using the National Missing and Unidentified Persons System and other resources. The liaison is to facilitate trainings for law enforcement and consult with community organizations that serve indigenous populations to promote community relations and develop best practices.
