Research Analysis

The proposed committee substitute for HB 2848 creates the Municipal Election Reform Act of 2021. It also modifies when a county, school district, technology center school district, municipality, fire protection district or other political subdivision can call an election to state they can call one on the first Tuesday after the first Monday of November in an odd-numbered year. However, the provisions do not apply to a special election called by the governor to fill a vacancy in an elected office. All municipal elections in a municipality with a population in excess of one hundred thousand (100,000) persons, according to the most recent federal decennial census, shall be partisan.
