Research Analysis

HB 2864, as introduced, modifies an exemption from provisions of the Electrical Licensing Act. Class 2 and Class 3 circuits are currently exempted. The measure limits the exemption to the portion of the wiring system between the load side of those circuits and the connected equipment utilized for installation of security, access control, video surveillance, fire alarm, fire sprinkler, nurse call systems, communications equipment, voice, video, audio and certain other uses.

Fiscal Analysis

Officials with the Oklahoma Construction Industries Board indicate the measure attempts to fix an unintended consequence arising from a 2018 measure (HB 2935) that exempted certain technical electrical work from licensing under the Electrical Licensing Act. By proving a remedy there may be additional applications for licenses, however the number is unknown and is not expected to be significant. Currently, the measure is not expected to result in fiscal costs or savings or have a measureable impact to revenue.
