HB 2911 exempts the Department of Tourism and Recreation from the requirement that state agencies allocate 1.5% of expenditures for capital projects to the Oklahoma Arts Council to fund the Art in Public Places Act.

**Fiscal Analysis**

HB 2911 exempts the Oklahoma Department of Tourism and Recreation from having to allocate one and one-half percent (1 1/2 %) of funds being used for capital projects to the Oklahoma Art in Public Places Act various revolving funds. All other agencies included shall continue to allocate said money to the revolving funds associated with the Oklahoma Art in Public Places Act.
