Fiscal Analysis

HB2928 requires several public entities (listed below) to turn in to the Oklahoma Department of Commerce and Rural Broadband Expansion Council “broadband network area coverage map data of all assets and network coverage.” Additionally, private broadband providers must also submit “network area coverage map data,” along with maximum upload and download speeds available to customers to the Department and Council. The Department and Council shall yearly update the coverage map required of them by 17 O.S. § 139.202. The Department believes that this additional work, along with other additional responsibilities around broadband use and regulation found in other measures of the 1st Session of the 58th Legislature, that it will need one additional Full Time Employee to cover the work. The Department believes that salary and benefits should be about \$85,000.

Officials at OneNet believe that the cost to comply is about \$25,000.

Officials at the Office of Management and Enterprise Services does not see a fiscal impact for this bill.

Officials at the Oklahoma Department of Transportation believe that any costs in reporting information would be minimal.
