Research Analysis

HB2930, as introduced, modifies the Oklahoma Agriculture Enhancement and Diversification Program which promotes the interests of agriculture through grants and loans.

Modifications to the program include:

- Inclusion of grants and loans for agritourism.
- The elimination of cooperative marketing loans for entities that intend to work together
- The inclusion of grants and loans for value-added agriculture
- Inclusion of grants for veteran or young farmer grants
- The prohibition of grants for growing, or any other aspect of medical marijuana

The measure eliminates the Agriculture Department's authority to allocate funds on a matching basis. The measure also exempts certain information submitted to the Agriculture Department from the Open Records Act.
