**Research Analysis**

HB 2974, as introduced, requires the State Election Board to perform an annual query, no later than June 1 of each year, to determine how many individuals are registered at the same residential address. If more than ten registered voters share a single residential address, the State Election Board must provide a list to the secretary of the county election board who will notify the county's district attorney to investigate any potential criminal violations. This does not apply to voters at nursing homes, veterans centers, medical facilities, multiunit housing, or unformed or overseas voters.
