Research Analysis

HB3026 raises the price of fingerprinting by county sheriffs, from \$5 to \$15, per card.

The senate amendment clarifies that sheriffs cannot charge more than \$15 per fingerprinting card and restores the title.

Fiscal Analysis

The Senate amendments to the measure restore the title and clarify that the fee charged by sheriffs for fingerprinting services are not to exceed \$15.00.

Upon review, the Senate amendments do not alter the fiscal impact of the measure as passed by the House. No direct fiscal impact to the state is anticipated from passage of the measure. Sheriffs, which are county officers, may see an increase in revenue from passage of the measure.
