**Research Analysis**

The proposed committee substitute to HB 3157 removes the power of municipalities to regulate the carrying of firearms or other deadly weapons. The measure bars any proclamation by the Governor during a state of emergency from containing any prohibition on the manufacture, possession or use of explosives or combustibles that are components used for the manufacture of firearm ammunition or from prohibiting or restricting the business or operations of a firearms or ammunition manufacturer, distributor, wholesaler, supplier, retailer, or a gun range.

**Fiscal Analysis**

The measure relates to the prohibition of municipalities to regulate the carrying of firearms and further prohibits certain firearms related activity during a state of emergency. The provisions are not expected to result in any measurable costs or savings to the state or municipalities.
