**Research Analysis**

HB 3166 creates the Southeast Asia Trade Office, an administrative component of the Oklahoma Department of Commerce with a physical office in Taipei, Taiwan. The trade office will:

- Facilitate economic relationships between businesses in Oklahoma and southeast Asia;
- Promote Oklahoma businesses and provide them with information and training about trading opportunities;
- Facilitate positive relationships between Oklahoma and its political subdivisions with governments in southeast Asia;
- Coordinate business outreach and fund travel;
- Coordinate actions at the federal level to promote business transactions between entities in southeast Asia and the United States, with an emphasis on Oklahoma; and
- Produce promotional and education materials about the mission of the trade office.
