## **Research Analysis**

The CS to HB 3191 allows any person in compliance with the provisions of the Oklahoma Self-Defense Act and in possession of a valid state photo identification card, driver license or valid handgun license or military identification card to carry a concealed or unconcealed firearm while hunting or fishing. The measure provides that law enforcement may not disarm a person without reasonable suspicion if the person displays a valid driver license or identification card. The measure provides that a person in possession of a firearm must disclose possession when instructed by a law enforcement officer.
