Research Analysis

HB 3191 modifies definitions used in the Oklahoma Self-Defense Act. The measure allows for the carrying of a firearm where the barrel of the firearm is safely pointed in a general up or down direction. The measure allows any person in compliance with the provisions of the Oklahoma Self-Defense Act and in possession of a valid state photo identification card, driver license or valid handgun license or military identification card to carry a concealed or unconcealed firearm while hunting or fishing. The measure provides that law enforcement may not disarm a person without reasonable suspicion if the person displays a valid driver license or identification card. The measure provides that a person in possession of a firearm must disclose possession when instructed by a law enforcement officer.
