Research Analysis

HB3232 provides that if the federal government makes election laws that go against Oklahoma election law, then those laws will be followed only during separately held federal elections. Determination on these laws will be made by the Oklahoma Attorney General. The Secretary of the State Election Board will temporarily alter rules so that no other elections are held on the same day as the federal election.

Fiscal Analysis

Upon review and with consultation from the State Election Board, passage of the measure may have a fiscal impact. The Board estimates a cost of approximately \$1 million – \$1.5 million per additional election required. The estimated cost for developing and maintaining separate "State" and "Federal" voter registration databases has not yet been determined. Additional appropriations would be needed to cover these costs.
