**Research Analysis**

HB 3240 prohibits a physician or other health care professional from providing or referring gender transition procedures to any individual under eighteen years old. The measure prohibits the use of public monies to any entity, organization, or individual who provides gender transition procedures to an individual under eighteen years old.

The measure prohibits insurance coverage for gender transition procedures within this state for individuals under eighteen years of age. Health benefit plans under an insurance policy in this state are prohibited to include reimbursement for gender transition procedures for a person under eighteen years old. Health benefit plans are not required to provide coverage for gender transition procedures. The bill provides legal remedies for violations of this act.
