Research Analysis

The proposed subcommittee substitute for HB3262 requires public schools to meet class size limitations if certain funding levels are appropriated. If a school fails to meet the class size limits they will be assessed a financial penalty.

If the amount of money appropriated for the financial support of public schools is:

- \$50 million more than it was in FY22, then schools will receive a financial penalty for having a second grade class size greater than 20.
- \$100 million more than it was in FY22, then schools will receive a financial penalty for having a third grade class size greater than 20.
- \$150 million more than it was in FY22, then schools will receive a financial penalty for having a fourth grade class size greater than 20.
- \$200 million... grade 5
- \$250 million... grade 6
- \$300 million... grade 7
- \$350 million... grade 8
- \$500 million... grades 9-12

Fiscal Analysis

The measure in its current form modifies class size requirements contingent upon certain state appropriations to the financial support of public schools ranging from \$50 million to \$500 million. The new requirements are applicable to grades two (2) through twelve (12), and the school district would assessed a financial penalty if the class size requirements are not met.
