## **Research Analysis**

HB 3283 lowers the penalty for cockfighting from a felony to a misdemeanor. Lowers the penalty for providing a building for the purpose of holding a cockfight from a felony to a misdemeanor. Lowers the penalty for any act or service in the furtherance of or to facilitate a cockfight from a felony to a misdemeanor. The penalty for the misdemeanor convictions is a fine of not more than \$500. For a second conviction the fine is \$1,000. A third or subsequent conviction is a fine of not more than \$2,000.

## **Fiscal Analysis**

The measure, as introduced, lowers the penalties for various cockfighting crimes from a felony to a misdemeanor. The measure also removes the prison sentence option for an individual convicted of a cockfighting misdemeanor.
