Fiscal Analysis

The measure includes provision in which the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation (OSBI) is directed to, each month, identify cases which are clean slate eligible by searching the criminal history repository records. OSBI is further directed to provide a list of such clean slate cases to the prosecuting agency and the arresting agency on a monthly basis.

OSBI is further directed to provide to the courts a list of all cases where responses from all parties were received and no objections were made. The courts are directed to review the list and provide to all agencies possessing criminal history records a signed expungement order for all cases approved.

Estimates of any potential costs associated with the provisions of the measure are not determined at present.
