## **Research Analysis**

The PCS2 to HB 3319 defines the following terms:

- Board
- health care employer
- healthcare provider

The measure authorizes the licensing staff of the Board to grant a temporary license to a health care provider under certain conditions. The temporary license will expire ninety days after the expiration of the state or national emergency declaration. The measure prohibits any health care provider who is issued a temporary license to initiate a prescription for controlled drugs, including opioids, without obtaining the proper permits from certain agencies. PCS2 authorizes the Board to issue temporary licenses to nurses pursuant to the requirements of this act. The measure declares an emergency.
