Research Analysis

The committee substitute to HB 3414 allows universities, institutions of higher education and research facilities in Oklahoma to conduct clinical trials on psilocybin and psilocin for the treatment of certain ailments and provides the requirements for the study or clinical trial. The State Department of Health is required to promulgate rules and regulations necessary to implement the program. The CS provides certain exemptions from criminal and civil penalties and provides specific civil penalties for non-compliance of the act. The measure declares an emergency.
