**Research Analysis**

The floor amendment to HB 3414 strikes all references of the words; *application, applicant* or *licensee* and replaces it with; *registration* or *registrant*.

FA1 allows universities, institutions of higher education and research facilities in Oklahoma to conduct clinical trials on psilocybin and psilocin for the treatment of certain ailments. FA1 also provides the requirements for the study or clinical trial. The State Department of Health is required to promulgate rules and regulations necessary to implement the program. FA1 provides certain exemptions from criminal and civil penalties and provides specific civil penalties for non-compliance of the act. The measure declares an emergency.
