Research Analysis

HB 3414 allows universities, institutions of higher education and research facilities in Oklahoma to conduct clinical trials on psilocybin and psilocin for the treatment of certain ailments. The measure provides the requirements for the study or clinical trial.

The measure also requires the State Department of Health to promulgate rules and regulations necessary to implement the program. The bill provides certain exemptions from criminal and civil penalties and provides specific civil penalties for non-compliance of the act.

The measure declares an emergency.
