## **Fiscal Analysis**

The committee substitute to the measure would create the Service Oklahoma division within the Office of Management and Enterprise Services. The substitute would transfer the applicable powers, duties, and responsibilities of the Driver License Services Division of the Department of Public Safety to Service Oklahoma. The substitute would transfer the applicable powers, duties, and responsibilities of the Motor Services Division of the Tax Commission to Service Oklahoma.

Upon review, passage of the measure will likely have a fiscal impact to the State. The measure is under review for further fiscal analysis. Affected agencies have been contacted and the impact will be updated as additional information is made available.

The current FY-2022 budget for the Driver License Services Division of DPS is \$43,277,338. Of this total, approximately \$26,704,445 is general revenue appropriations.

The current FY-2022 budget for the Motor Services division of OTC is \$5,328,240. Of that total, approximately \$4,838,418 is general revenue appropriations.
