Research Analysis

HB 3419 transfers all powers, duties, responsibilities and employees relating to the issuance of driver licenses and motor vehicle license registration from the Oklahoma Department of Public Safety and the Oklahoma Tax Commission to the newly created Service Oklahoma, a division of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services.

Fiscal Analysis

The measure, as introduced, would create the Service Oklahoma division within the Office of Management and Enterprise Services. The measure would transfer the applicable powers, duties, and responsibilities of the Driver License Services Division of the Department of Public Safety to Service Oklahoma. The measure would transfer the applicable powers, duties, and responsibilities of the Motor Services Division of the Tax Commission to Service Oklahoma.

Upon review, passage of the measure will likely have a fiscal impact to the State. The measure is under review for further fiscal analysis. Affected agencies have been contacted and the impact will be updated as additional information is made available.
