Research Analysis

HB3647 creates the Oklahoma Golf Trail Commission whose goal is to stimulate economic development, enhance tourism and quality of life in Oklahoma and to attract new residents to the state. The Commission will consist of nine members that serve six year terms and meet at least quarterly. Commission members are to create a list of 15 to 25 golf courses annually that will be listed as the official Oklahoma Golf Trail. The commission can be funded by private donations until permanent appropriations are allocated.
