Research Analysis

HB 3648 creates Mackenzie's Law. The measure provides that a preliminary hearing be commenced no later than nine months from the initial appearance of the defendant. If commencement of the preliminary hearing is delayed past the nine month time limit, a show cause hearing is to be scheduled by the court.

The Senate amendment provides that if the court fails to find good cause for the delay, the court is to schedule a preliminary hearing as soon as practicable.
