**Research Analysis**

The PCS to HB 3747 creates the Judge Timothy Henderson Act. The measure provides that it is unlawful for a judge in any court to engage in a sexual relationship with a lawyer who is representing a client in a civil or criminal action or proceeding or prosecuting a criminal case on behalf of the state or municipality in a pending case before the same judge. The penalty is a felony punishable by imprisonment for not more than 2 years, a fine of not less than \$5,000 nor more than \$100,000 or both fine and imprisonment.
