**Research Analysis**

The committee substitute for HB 3813 authorizes the Oklahoma Medical Marijuana Authority (OMMA) to seize any illegal marijuana or marijuana product, refer evidence, reports, or charges regarding violations of law to appropriate law enforcement and prosecutorial authority, and aid enforcement authorities in prosecutions of violations that carry criminal penalties discovered during investigations. The measure provides that all OMMA investigators must meet training requirements and qualifications for peace officers and allows such investigators, as well as the director of enforcement, to arrest violators or suspected violators of laws committed in their presence. The director and investigators may assist in the apprehension and arrest of a violator or suspected violator upon request of a sheriff or peace officer of the state. The measure also allows the executive director of OMMA to employ or contract with attorneys legal advice and representation.
