**Research Analysis**

The conference committee substitute for HB 3929 allows process validation as an acceptable testing practice for medical marijuana. The CCS provides that process validation is to be voluntary and lays out required standards, policies, and procedures for process validation. The Oklahoma Medical Marijuana Authority (OMMA) must develop standards and requirements for a licensee to achieve process validation by January 1, 2024, including a process for biannual inspections and punishment for violations of process validation.
