**Research Analysis**

The committee substitute for HB 3971 directs the Oklahoma Medical Marijuana Authority (OMMA) to employ secret shoppers to purchase medical marijuana from licensed dispensaries for the purpose of conducting compliance tests. Beginning January 2023, OMMA must inspect by secret shopper a minimum of 50 licensed dispensaries annually. In 2025, 10 percent of dispensaries must be inspected by secret shopper. The measure provides guidelines for failed test results and directs OMMA to implement rules to enforce the provisions of the act.
