Research Analysis

CCS B for HB 4055 requires all existing medical marijuana grower licensees to inform retail suppliers or electric cooperatives utilized of their licensed status within 30 days of the effective date of the measure. Any growers who receive their licenses after the effective date of the measure must inform retail suppliers or electric cooperatives of their licensed status at the time of the connection of services. Growers must provide monthly reports with the amount of electricity and water used to the Oklahoma Medical Marijuana Authority (OMMA) monthly in an electronic format that can be integrated with the seed-to-sale software. OMMA is directed to develop rules, exemptions, and procedures for metering the usage of electricity and water that are not supplied by retail suppliers or electric cooperatives, including the usage of well water and gas-powered generators. Refusal or failure to submit the monthly usage reports or use of an unpermitted water source will result in the permanent revocation of the grower license.
