**Research Analysis**

The committee substitute for HB 4055 requires public utilities report to the Oklahoma Medical Marijuana Authority (OMMA) the amount of any commodity supplied by the public utility to licensed medical marijuana grow operations. The reports are to be submitted monthly in an electronic format integrated with OMMA's seed-to-sale software. The measure directs OMMA to develop rules and procedures for metering the usage of water, electricity, and other forms of commodities used by growers that are not supplied by public utility companies, including the usage of well water and gas-powered generators.
