Research Analysis

The committee substitute to HB 4138 allows the carrying of a firearm on public property at events held on the fairgrounds and in buildings of the fairgrounds that are open to the public during the Oklahoma State Fair or the Tulsa State Fair. The measure prohibits the carrying of firearms in any public building used for a public meeting conducted under the Oklahoma Open Meeting Act, in any public facility providing substance abuse or mental health services or facilities providing substance abuse programs to persons under supervision of the state, or in the State Capitol Building. The measure allows for the prohibition to carry firearms at a national softball tournament event at the Oklahoma Softball Hall of Fame Complex or a national or international Quarter Horse event.
