Research Analysis

HB 4327 prohibits a physician from knowingly performing or inducing an abortion on a pregnant woman. The measure specifies that the act will be enforced exclusively through private civil actions with certain requirements. The bill specifies damages if a claimant prevails in an action brought under the act. The measure also specifies defenses and non-defenses to actions brought under this act. HB 4327 prohibits the state, a state official, or a district from intervening in an action brought under this bill.
