The Senate amendments to HB 4373 modifies the elements of third degree burglary to include the theft of tires, wheels, and catalytic converters. The measure provides a fine for burglary in the third degree to be not more than \$5,000.

Fiscal Analysis

The Senate amendments to the measure would only restore title to the measure.

Upon review, the Senate amendments to the measure would not alter the fiscal impact of the measure as passed by the House. The measure would expand the scope of a felony, and could potentially cause an increase in incarceration costs borne by the Department of Corrections as well as potentially increase fine revenue received by the state. The exact amount would depend on the number and disposition of cases.
