## **Research Analysis**

The Senate amendment to HB 4374 names the act the Stephen Bernius Memorial Act and modifies the definition of "family or household members" as used in the Protection from Domestic Abuse Act and the Domestic Abuse Reporting Act to include persons not related by blood or marriage living in the same household. Provides a definition of "living in the same household" to mean persons who regularly reside in the same, single dwelling unit; persons wo resided in the dwelling within the past year; or persons who have individual lease agreements where each person has their own private bedroom and shares the common areas.

The Senate amendments to the measure would add a section naming the measure the "Stephen Bernius Memorial Act".
