## **Research Analysis**

HB 4376 creates the crime of "smash-and-grab burglary". A person who intentionally enters a mercantile establishment with the intent to commit a theft which results in discernible damage to the mercantile establishment in excess of \$500 is guilty of smash-and-grab burglary. Punishment is a felony subject to not less than 2 nor more than 10 years imprisonment, a fine of not less than \$10,000, or both fine and imprisonment. Second and subsequent convictions subject the person to not less than 4 years nor more than 20 years imprisonment, a fine of not less than \$20,000, or both fine and imprisonment.
