**Research Analysis**

The floor amendment to HB4388 requires 5 percent of the Lottery Commission's gross proceeds to be deposited in to the Teacher Empowerment Revolving Fund. This money shall go toward funding advanced, lead, and master teaching certificate salary increases.

The amendment removes language requiring any monies in excess of \$60 million going to the Teacher Empowerment Revolving Fund.

The amendment requires the State Board of Equalization to ensure that monies from the Empowerment Fund are not supplanting other education funding.
