**Research Analysis**

The proposed subcommittee substitute for HB4388 requires any net proceeds deposited to the Oklahoma Education Lottery Trust Fund that exceed sixty million dollars to be deposited into the Teacher Empowerment Fund and be used to fund the salary supplements for teachers with lead and master certificates. The funds will be distributed on a first-come first-serve basis to those in the program and will serve as a state match to local public school dollars allocated to lead and master teacher salary supplements.
