**Fiscal Analysis**

The total fiscal impact of this measure is two million, six hundred fifty-one thousand six hundred forty-three dollars (\$2,651,643.00). The breakdown is as follows:

- \$300,000.00 for Commerce's Automotive Initiative;
- \$350,000.00 for Roger's State University TV Project;
- \$188,187.00 for Community Enhancement of Nutrition Assistance;
- \$437,919.00 for Community Action Agency Partners;
- \$60,000.00 for Sub-State Planning Districts;
- \$503,258.00 for Seminole State Rural Business and Resources Center;
- \$100,000.00 for Commerce's ACES Program; and
- \$712,279.00 for the Film and Music Office that was transferred to Commerce last year.
